In this lecture, professor Rosa shares his thoughts on "Sociology of World Relations: If Critique alone does not help, what is next?", the theme of the colloquium he and fellow researchers at the Max Weber Kolleg will organize in collaboration with the University of Humanistic Studies: **15/16 February 2024**, Kromme Nieuwegracht 29, Utrecht, rooms 0.38 and 1.40.
